Clean Vehicles Updates

- Submit Application
 - School/Contact Information
 - Fleet Survey, Bus Quote, Emissions Cert
 - Signature Page
- Response in @2 Weeks
- Site Visit
- Reservation Letter/Board Agenda
- Contract—1 Year
- New Vehicle Order/Old Vehicle Destroy
- Invoice
- Report
 - 4 Reports/Year

Clean Vehicles Updates

- Submit any number of buses
 - No obligation to move forward
 - You choose—grants are per-vehicle
- Tiered Analysis
 - Increase grant by shuffling buses
 - Must report on all buses in contract
- White fleet eligible as well
 - Harder to qualify, but available

Clean Vehicles Updates

- Up to 75% of vehicle costs
 - Must cut engine and chassis
- New Option: 3-5 Year Projects
 - Grant is pro-rated
- Still Fuel-Neutral
 - BUT Alternative Fuel Projects get higher cost-effectiveness

Clean Vehicles Updates

- Expected mileage should be constant
 - We follow up, may ask ??s
 - Solutions for low-mile issues
- Accelerated Deployment
 - Your turnover data can help

Refuel Station Grants

- Now 2 Options:
 - Old/Emissions/Fleet-Based
 - New/Qualitative/Public
- Old Option: Chicken or Egg?
 - Fund fleet or fuel station
 - Based on fleet emissions decrease
 - Grants the same fleet or fuel

Refuel Station Grants

- New Option: Chicken AND Egg
 - WITH Public Access
 - 25-75% of Station Equipment Costs
 - Submit Vehicles together or later
 - “Public” can be buses and trucks
 - Don't have to allow Joe's CNG Pickup

Refuel Station Grants

- Provide Business/Marketing Plan
 - Estimated Fuel Volume
 - Vehicle Counts
 - Project Personnel
 - Budget
- Reporting is 10 years (fuel volume)

Refuel Station Grants

Scoring Rubric Funding Table for Public Infrastructure Projects

Overall Score	Funding Percentage
20-35 Points	25% Eligible Costs
36-50 Points	35% Eligible Costs
51-65 Points	45% Eligible Costs
66-80 Points	55% Eligible Costs
81-95 Points	65% Eligible Costs
96-110 Points	75% Eligible Costs
