The following students will be used for the Emergency Event and Managing Student Behavior. You will need to familiarize yourself with these students and their specific challenges.

## **Student Profiles:**

**Jane** is 18-year-old in a wheelchair with TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury) due to a major car accident. She misses her life that she has before, being able to do everything for herself, play basketball, an everyday regular ed high school senior life. Sometimes she will be upset as she says she's not Special Needs and shouldn't be on the bus with special needs students because While in any vehicle she still tends to get nervous since the accident 2 years ago. During the drive she will call out to the driver letting them know if the turns or stops scare her. If she's doing ok, she will call to the driver and say "good job"

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**Ula** is a 17-year-old AB (Adaptive Behavior) student. She doesn't like authority. When given instructions, it should be done in a soft-spoken matter and always keep it simple watching facial expressions as well otherwise she can be set off. Don't speak to hear unless she speaks to you first. If she gets upset, she's ready to fight and starts using vulgar language. Otherwise, she's will get on and off the bus with no issues.

**Eloise** is 15-year-old with Dysphagia and Allergy. She is non-verbal but is known to make some sounds and randomly says, big house, blue car, alphabet, color, bluey runs fast. Sometimes she may repeat the sounds or random phrases. Eloise also has problems with transition and can be very stubborn if she doesn't want to do something if she doesn't want to. Using the emergency exit alarm helps "motivate" her to move, getting on or off the bus
